1. Try to describe what "*a darkness to be felt*" (Ex. 10:21) might be like. How do you think it would feel?

2. (*The following referencing Pastor Patrick's opening story about a guided tour through a cave*) Talk about a world plunged into darkness (*Gen. 3*) and yet still thinking it can see (*c.f. Judges 17:6*). How is this possible? Have you ever experienced it yourself?

3. Read Rom. 1:18-32. How does this inform the previous question?

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
